Q: Please provide a brief biography of yourself for the voters.

Q: What are one or two pressing challenges of the upcoming term and how would you approach them?

A: Traffic congestion and aging infrastructure pose significant barriers to our economic growth and quality of life. As an RTM member I would suggest smarter transportation planning that integrates long-term growth with community needs. This includes modernizing roads and bridges, expanding and improving public transit options, and enhancing pedestrian and cyclist safety.

Q: In April, the Board of Estimate and Taxation (BET) voted to reduce the Greenwich Public Schools budget by approximately \$4 million. This reduction allowed GPS to increase its budget year over year by 3% (vs 5%). [Minutes of the FY 2025-2026 Budget Decision Day Three (3) Meeting of the BET held April 4, 2025]. What is your position on this decision?

A: The BET 's decision to reduce the Greenwich Public Schools is concerning. It fails to adequately account for rising inflation, contractual obligations and the needs of our students. Along with our beautiful shoreline and bucolic parks, strong schools are a central component of our community. All of which bolster our property values. As a member of the RTM I would support fair and reliable funding, attract and retain excellent educators and invest in modern facilities so every student has the opportunity to thrive.
