Q: Please provide a brief biography of yourself for the voters.

A: I'm seeking my 5th term on the RTM representing Old Greenwich. My priorities include: sustaining our excellent public education while investing in school facilities that meet Board of Education specifications; repairing our playing fields; upgrading our infrastructure to combat flooding and address climate change impacts; preserving trees and green spaces essential for flood control; advancing age-friendly community programs; enhancing pedestrian safety throughout town especially sidewalks in Old Greenwich. I live in OG with my family - our daughter is a senior at GHS.

Q: What are one or two pressing challenges of the upcoming term and how would you approach them?

A: Balancing all the upcoming infrastructure projects that have been put off for decades and are coming due at the same time and balancing the desire to maintain a low mill rate - which everyone wants. I support our capital projects and think the town should consider long term financing.

Q: In April, the Board of Estimate and Taxation (BET) voted to reduce the Greenwich Public Schools budget by approximately \$4 million. This reduction allowed GPS to increase its budget year over year by 3% (vs 5%). [Minutes of the FY 2025-2026 Budget Decision Day Three (3) Meeting of the BET held April 4, 2025]. What is your position on this decision?

A: I strongly oppose this cut to the GPS budget.**Q: Number of Terms on RTM (Incumbents only)**
